**Erato** Erato, the goddess of Greek mythology derived her name from the word "lovely," which is what this aromatic, steel fermented wine is. The distinct aroma comes from a small portion of Muscat Blanc a Petit Grains grown on slate soils in our highest elevation vineyard. It is a splendid aperitif wine. 12.1% alcohol

Stainless Steel Roussanne, 2021 We made a special cuvee for members only (only 794 bottles produced). Usually we age Roussanne for a year in new and neutral French Oak barrels, but this year set aside a small batch to be bottled directly from the steel fermentation tanks. It's still the delicious Roussanne you love, but it's lighter. 12.4% alcohol

Roussanne, 2021 Roussanne returns to Muse after an absence of a few years when we were exclusively blending it with Marsanne and Viognier to make our Rhone blend called Thalia. A white grape variety, Roussanne is aged for one year in new and neutral French oak barrels. It has undergone a partial malolactic fermentation and has notes of peach and apple and a long finish. This wine is great to drink now, but could also be put in the cellar and enjoyed for the next several years. 12.4% alcohol

Vin Gris de Gamay, 2021 Fermented in the winery in a style somewhere between rosé and a light-bodied red wine, this vin gris is made from Gamay grapes grown in both upper and lower vineyards here in the dry, beautiful and historic Shenandoah Valley. 11.8% alcohol

**Chardonnay, 2021** This Chardonnay is made only from grapes grown at Muse Vineyards in the dry, beautiful and historic Shenandoah Valley of Virginia. It is fermented in French oak barrels in the style of Burgundy's great Chardonnays. 13.3% alcohol

**Pichet** Named for the humble "pichets" (wine carafes) of French cafes, this red wine is light-bodied, and refreshing. It is a blend of grapes produced exclusively from our younger vines. It is fermented in stainless steel and bottled early. Serve slightly chilled and enjoy it as the wine of boulevardiers and resting Moulin Rouge dancers. 13.60% alcohol

Gamay, 2021 A native of southern Burgundy, the Gamay vine excels on soils like those found at Muse Vineyards. A consensus favorite of sommeliers, we are pleased to have contributed to the renaissance in the U.S. of this irresistible bistro wine of France. 12.7% alcohol

**Nebbiolo, 2019** Nebbiolo is a grape that originates in the Piedmont region of northern Italy. Like the famous Barolo and Barbaresco wines famously associated with this grape, Muse Vineyards' version is rich, full-bodied and chewy. Aging three years in new and neutral French oak has given this wine a fine finish with substantial tannins. The aroma and flavor are suggestive of truffles and violets. 14.6% alcohol
